

Juror

Doug Jeppesen holds a BA in Art History and a BFA in Art with an emphasis in ceramics from the University of Tulsa, and a MFA from Northern Illinois University. Doug holds the title of Associate Professor of Art/Ceramics at Waubensee Community College in Sugar Grove, Illinois where he has taught full time since 1998. He specializes in wood firing and has built six different styled wood fired kilns at the college. Doug prefers to fire his work in the anagama, which was completed during the fall of 2006 and is one of only three in the state of Illinois. Firing this fourteen-foot-long kiln over 90 hours offers the opportunity to explore multiple zones within one firing, and enables the work to achieve a varied palette simultaneously depending on location and placement. His work has appeared in numerous national juried and invitational exhibitions across the United States. Doug has presented workshops at colleges, universities, and art centers internationally. He was a panel member during the International Wood Firing Conference hosted by Northern Arizona University, and at the 2nd European Wood Fire Conference hosted by Guladagergaard International Ceramic Research Center in Skaelskor Denmark. Most recently, he organized and hosted the 2016 International Wood Fire Conference at Waubensee Community College.

This exhibition is open to all ceramic artists over the age of 18 who currently reside in the Central Time Zone. Central Time Zone states include: Alabama, Arkansas, Florida, Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Kentucky, Louisiana, Missouri, Mississippi, Minnesota, Nebraska, North Dakota, South Dakota, Oklahoma, Tennessee, Texas, and Wisconsin; however not all counties within these states are within the Central Time Zone. Artists who reside in areas of Canada and Mexico that are within the Central Time Zone are also eligible. If you are unsure if your location qualifies please contact us.

Artwork submitted must have been completed within the last three years. All forms of ceramic expression are encouraged.

Awards

Entry Fee

Each artist must pay a non-refundable entry fee of \$35 for up to three entries or \$50 for five entries. Please make checks payable to Bradley University.

Restrictions

All ceramic works must be packed within two boxes. The interior box must be no larger than 18"x18"x18", and the exterior box must not exceed 24"x24"x24".

Insurance value must be less than \$5,000

Delivery & Return of Artwork

The artist is responsible for delivering or shipping the artwork to and from the gallery. A bar-coded shipping label OR adequate postage for return shipping must be included with all shipped work. Be sure to label your work clearly so that it can be easily identified. Bradley University Galleries will store artwork for up to 30 days after the closing of the exhibition. After May 20, 2020, all unclaimed artwork will become the property of Bradley University.

Liability

Accepted artwork will be insured for the sale price or other stated value while it is in the custody of Bradley University. The artist is responsible for insuring the artwork while in transit.

Image Requirements

- Save image as a high quality JPG
- Image should have resolution of 300 dpi
- Label Images to correspond with entry form

Sales
