Interesting Facts:


Muntjacs make a sharp barking sound as their alarm call, which has given them the nickname of "barking deer." This sound is also common during their breeding season.

Muntjacs have excellent hearing and eyesight.


Muntjacs are the oldest deer species; fossil rem 15 to 35 million years ag


Males have canines that up to 1 inch long and small antiers











































































































